Recycling Lab Plastics

Plastic is ubiquitous in life science research, but not all plastics can be recycled.

PETE (or PET) and HDPE are the most commonly recycled plastics — in fact, recycled PETE is in high demand as a source material. Use this guide to identify and sort your non-hazardous laboratory plastics. And remember to check with your Environmental Health and Safety department and local recycling facilities on which types of plastics they accept.
